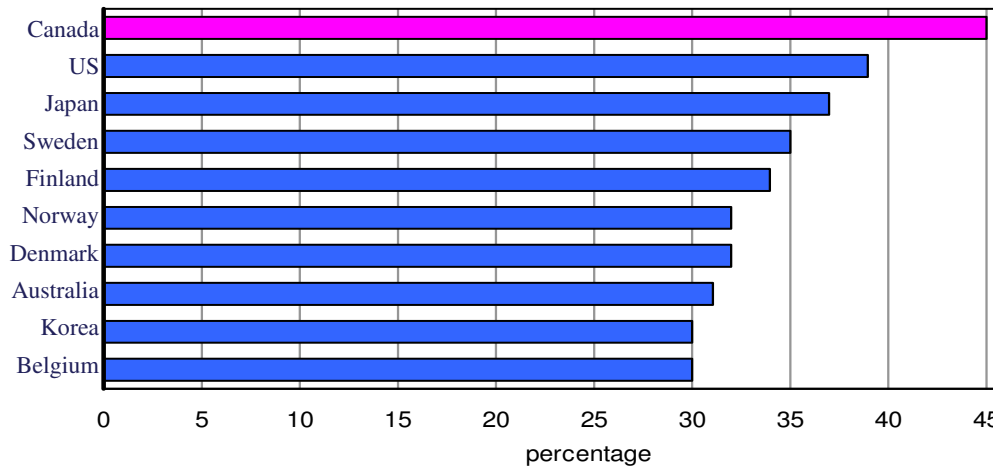


International Comparisons The Good News
