<p>1. Rationale or background, including Constitution/ByLaws references:</p> <p>1.1. The CSBA is committed to achieving excellence in public education through democratically elected school boards.</p> <p>1.2. The Constitution/ByLaws 7.4 establishes a Strategic Planning Committee that will be responsible for developing the strategic plan for approval by the Board of Directors in accordance with the Constitution/ByLaws and CSBA policy.</p> <p>2. Policy Statement:</p> <p>2.1. A Strategic Plan will enable the CSBA to focus its work on national priorities that will assist the CSBA in achieving its mission and vision.</p> <p>2.2. The CSBA's Strategic Planning Committee is tasked with developing a proposed strategic plan which focuses on the key priorities of the CSBA to present to the Board Of Directors for final approval.</p> <p>3. Procedures:</p> <p>3.1. Membership for the Strategic Planning Committee will be determined by the Board of Directors.</p> <p>3.2. The strategic plan should focus the work of the CSBA for a three to five year period and have a maximum of four (4) key priorities.</p> <p>3.3. The Strategic Planning Committee, when developing or revising the strategic plan, must consult with the Member Associations regarding all continuing and/or new priorities.</p> <p>3.4. If a Member Association wants to suggest a change to the strategic plan, a proposal to the Strategic Planning Committee should include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Background information (national status, initiatives already in place); ● Rationale for becoming a priority; ● Suggested initial steps in an action plan; <p>3.5. The Strategic Planning Committee will present its proposed strategic plan to the Board of Directors for final approval.</p> <p>3.6. Once a Strategic Plan is approved by the board, a Work Team for each key priority must be established in accordance with Policy 1.3.4.</p> <p>3.7. The CSBA Executive Director will monitor the progress of the Work Teams in achieving the strategic plan and report the progress to the Board of Directors.</p>
